### Extreme and Severe Weather Procedure

In times of extreme weather conditions, such as excessive cold or heavy snow, careful consideration should be given to the protection of the pupils and staff and to maintaining a productive learning environment.

This procedure contains the guidelines to be followed in the event of difficult weather conditions.

Where possible, it is the policy of the School to remain open, subject to the safety of our pupils and staff.

The school's website will contain up to date information.

#### In Preparation

If heavy snow is forecast, a warning will be sent out to parents via the School App and placed on the school website.

#### When will a decision be made and how do parents and staff know?

The Proprietors of the School, in conjunction with the Headmaster, will make a decision whether to open the School or not.

This decision will be based on:

- Is access to the school safe for children, parents and staff?
- If access is dangerous, can it be made safe before the arrival of children, parents and staff?
- Can enough staff members get to school to ensure an appropriate adult/child ratio?
- Are conditions likely to deteriorate during the day, impacting on the safe collection of children?
- Can the School provide meals for the children?
- Does the School have sufficient heating?
- Are the toilets working and is drinking and hand-washing water available?

#### Travelling to School in Extreme Weather

Staff members are asked to make every reasonable effort to get to school, although they must make a judgement about the safety of travelling in the extreme conditions. Members of staff are asked to contact the School (via Edupay) to let the Headmaster know if they are **unable** to get to school. If colleagues do not feel that they can drive due to the conditions, lift-sharing is a possibility. Staff, pupils

and parents are warned to exercise caution if they decide to walk into school, as the top end of Loxley Road can be very hazardous due to the lack of a pavement.

### **Will the School run as normal on these days?**

In the event that the School is operating with a smaller number of staff, the teachers available will organise a programme of events on a daily basis. This programme will obviously differ significantly from the usual daily timetable and routines.

### **Upon arrival at School in extreme weather**

Pupils should go to the following locations:

Prep children	- Theatre
Years Reception, 1 & 2	- Theatre
Little Crofters	- Normal classrooms

### **Pupil Footwear**

Parents are asked to ensure that pupils coming into school in snowy conditions arrive in boots or wellies, and bring their school shoes to change into. This ensures that they remain warm and dry in school, with the option to explore the snow during break times, where it is safe and appropriate to do so.

### **What happens if there is a need to close early?**

Once the School is open, we will aim to remain open until the end of the school day. In the event of extreme weather, or loss of services during the day, we will immediately announce an early closing via the School App, and contact parents to inform them. As the number of pupils remaining decreases, the children still awaiting collection will be taken to the Theatre, and await collection from there.

## Appendix 1

### School App (RMP) Message for Extreme/Severe Weather

Where possible, it is the policy of the School to remain open, subject to the safety of our pupils and staff.

Where extreme weather has been forecast a message will be sent via the School App.

### FAQ's

Q. I have a long journey home; can I collect my child early?

A. **Yes. Please ensure you sign your child out at the school office.**

Q. Will you still run Late Duty and Prep?

A. **We will run Late Duty for Pre-Prep and Early Years pupils with siblings in Years 3 – 6.**

Q. Will Wraparound be provided?

A. **Yes, if it is safe for pupils and staff to remain on site.**

Q. If my child does not attend due to extreme weather, how will his/her absence be recorded?

A. **The absence will be recorded as AUTHORISED.**

<b>Where heavy snow has fallen overnight:</b>		
	The Proprietors to liaise with the Headmaster to decide whether it is appropriate to open the School.	Headmaster & Directors
	The Estates Manager to liaise with the Business Manager and the Headmaster regarding school opening. Then to open up the School, clear essential paths, lay down salt/sand, and check all heating.	Estates Team
	Staff members <b>UNABLE</b> to get into school that day to update their <b>EduPay</b> .	All staff
	Where the School is to remain closed, a message will be sent to all parents via the School App and an email to staff informing of the decision. Staff and parents should assume the School will be open unless they hear otherwise.	Headmaster
	The website is updated.	Admin staff

	After ascertaining levels of staffing/pupil numbers, a decision will be made whether to progress with the normal timetable – maybe combining some classes – or whether to adopt a more ‘creative’ approach.	Headmaster/Deputy Head
